The homozygote polled bull CORD (PP) is a beef type Fleckvieh bull, who offers very good development and a sublime pedigree. His sire was a champion in 2012 and his dam's sire a reserve champion. Both bulls - in the paternal and maternal lines - combine calving ease with good muscularity

There are no Germanicus daughters in the Netherlands, but several descendants of Steinadler have been born here. This bull, with his score of 98 for calving ease scores high when used as a dual-purpose match. In Germany Steinadler is considered a good calving ease bull, scoring 118 for this trait.

CORD (PP) is a bull who can be used with confidence and he will certainly boost the beef traits of his progeny. He is well developed and has nicely correct feet and legs. CORD (PP) is ideal if your goal is a beef type Fleckvieh calf, as your calves will also all be born polled.
