

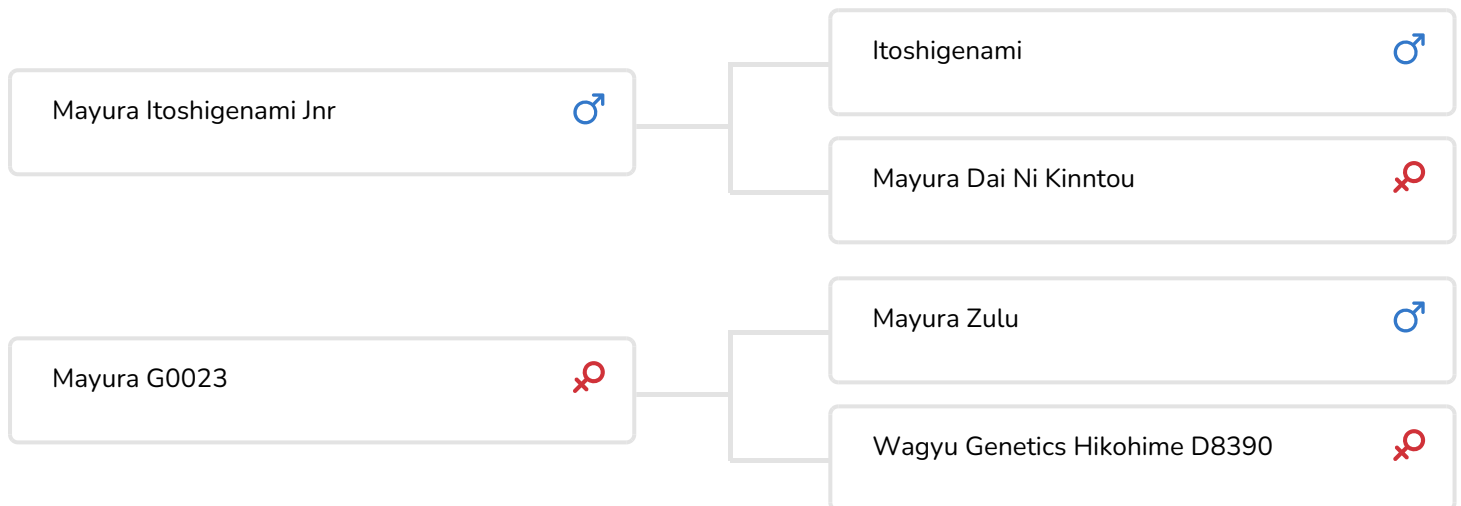

Mayura Pinnacle is an uncommon Wagyu bull from Australia. Mayura Pinnacle was bred by the famous Mayaru Station and has a truly unique sire - Mayura Itoshigenami Jnr. This bull is considered a once in a generation sire in Australia with more than 840 carcasses consistently graded an average of 9+ and progeny sold for more than 160,000 Australian dollars. His last straws sold commanded a price of 70,000 Australian dollars.

Pinnacle's dam also ranks among the elite performers at this stud in Australia. Her first offspring scored an average of 9.25 for carcass while the first bulls she produced each achieved prices of more than 53,000 Australian dollars.

Mayura Pinnacle is an absolutely faultless bull, and ranks universally in at least the top 5 for breeding values, with many of his traits classed in the top 1% of Australia. Mayura Pinnacle is a unique opportunity for every farmer who wants to breed exceptional cows.
