

Menno van de Plashoeve is the first son of Adamo to be tested by K.I. SAMEN from Ria 19. From the Ria line there have been several other bulls tested, all of whom have shown very good figures for calving ease.

With this bull we have Unicus van Phaeocryst as the sire's mother and she has had a very positive influence on growth and calving ease within the Plashoeve bunch. Adamo is a son of Ubidet, who also scores very good figures for calving ease. This is a positive combination especially for shorter gestation periods. As a 3rd calf cow this dam has only had one caesarian as a result of a calf that was lying backwards.

Seeing as how both his sire's and dam's side have a very good pedigree Menno is a very good contender to qualify as a bull who inherits the trait for easier births. Just as Bob van de Plashoeve, Menno also scores 4.5 on a scale of 5 for easy births.
